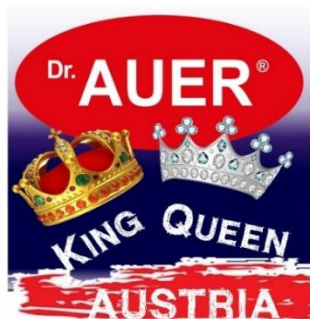

2. TRACK DETAILS

The ASKÖ Dr. AUER BMX Racing Team Mühlen are proud to welcome you to the Alpe Adria BMX Championship. The history of BMX racing in Mühlen dates to 2005. Since then, the facility has been upgraded and constantly growing with the 5 meter start hill and proline since has taken place in 2016. The track is approximately 342m

3. THE CITY OF MÜHLEN

The village of Mühlen was first mentioned in historical records around the year 1200.

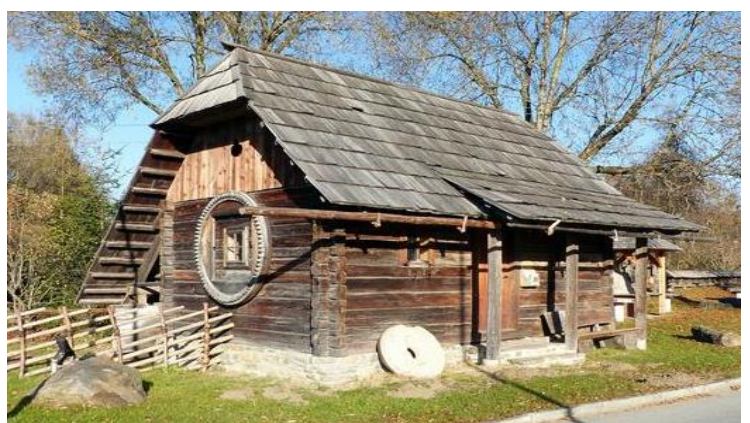
Mühlen is an idyllic market town with 945 inhabitants in the Murau district of Styria. This officially recognized recreational resort is situated on the sunny slopes of the Zirbitzkogel, nestled within the picturesque Zirbitzkogel-Grebenzen Nature Park. Known as the "Village of Mills," the region combines unspoiled nature with historic Celtic sites of spiritual energy.

Key attractions:

Hörfeld Moor – an internationally significant protected wetland providing a habitat for over 130 bird species. Keltenmuseum Noreia – an archaeological site and historical village dedicated to the legendary Celtic royal city of Noreia. The Dr. Auer BMX Arena, considered Austria's one of the largest BMX facility, is located in Mühlen. The international race track is the municipality's sporting flagship and home to the successful ASKÖ Dr. Auer BMX Racing Team Mühlen. Farmers' Museum & Old Mill – offering insights into historical rural life and the region's traditional craftsmanship. Mühlner Badesee – a natural "hidden gem" for swimmers, families, and anglers, featuring water temperatures of up to 26°C.

Activities and Leisure – Hiking & Mountaineering:

The hiking village boasts a network of over 100 kilometers of marked trails. A popular choice is the alpine hike leading directly to the summit of the Zirbitzkogel. Riding at the Dr. Auer BMX Arena in Mühlen is open to professionals, recreational riders, and beginners alike. If you would like to ride laps at one of Austria's largest facilities, there are clear procedures and requirements to follow. Family Experiences: Austria's first hiking fairy-tale trail, "Hans im Glück" (Lucky Hans), offers a playful journey through nature. Guided llama hikes round out the offerings. Camping by the Swimming Lake: The local campsite is the first in Austria to hold an official hiking quality seal and serves regional cuisine at its adjoining inn.

5. LOCATION

Mühlen is located approximately 38 kilometers southeast of Murau. The municipality's lowest point lies in the northwest along the Görtschitz River, at an elevation of 800 meters above sea level. To the east, the terrain rises to a plateau at an altitude of around 1,200 meters; this constitutes the inhabited area, which is bordered to the south—near the Carinthian border—by wooded mountains reaching just under 1,500 meters in height. Further east, the municipal territory rises to the Zirbitzkogel peak at 2,396 meters.

The nearest train station is Neumarkt in der Steiermark (served by regional trains), located approximately 12 km away. For long-distance trains, the station in Friesach (Carinthia) 22 km or Judenburg 45km. From there, buses or taxis run directly to Mühlen.

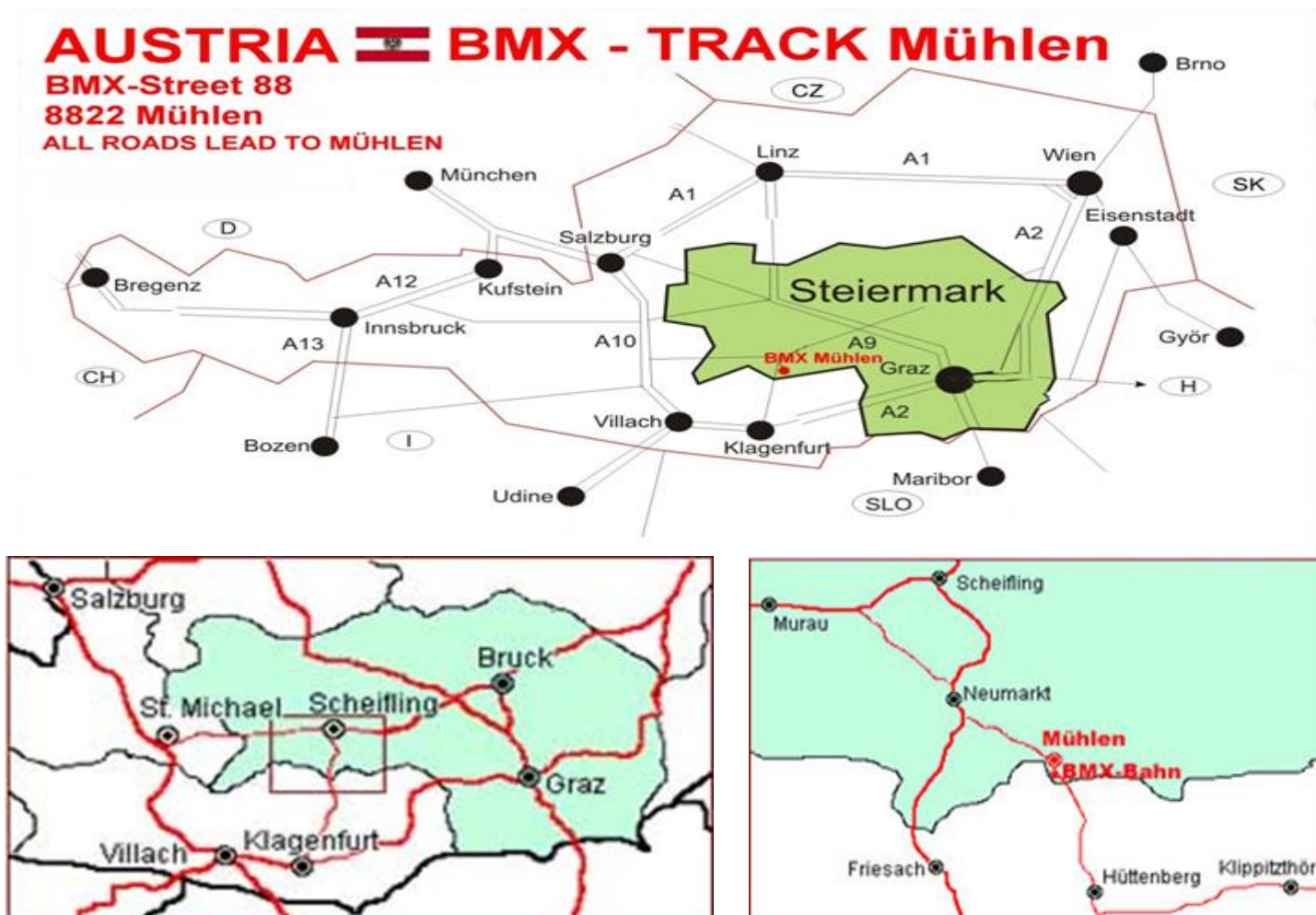
The route from Mühlen (Styria) to Klagenfurt Airport covers approximately 45 to 50 kilometers. The drive takes about 50 minutes. to Graz Airport covers approximately 111 kilometers. The drive takes about 1h 32 minutes.

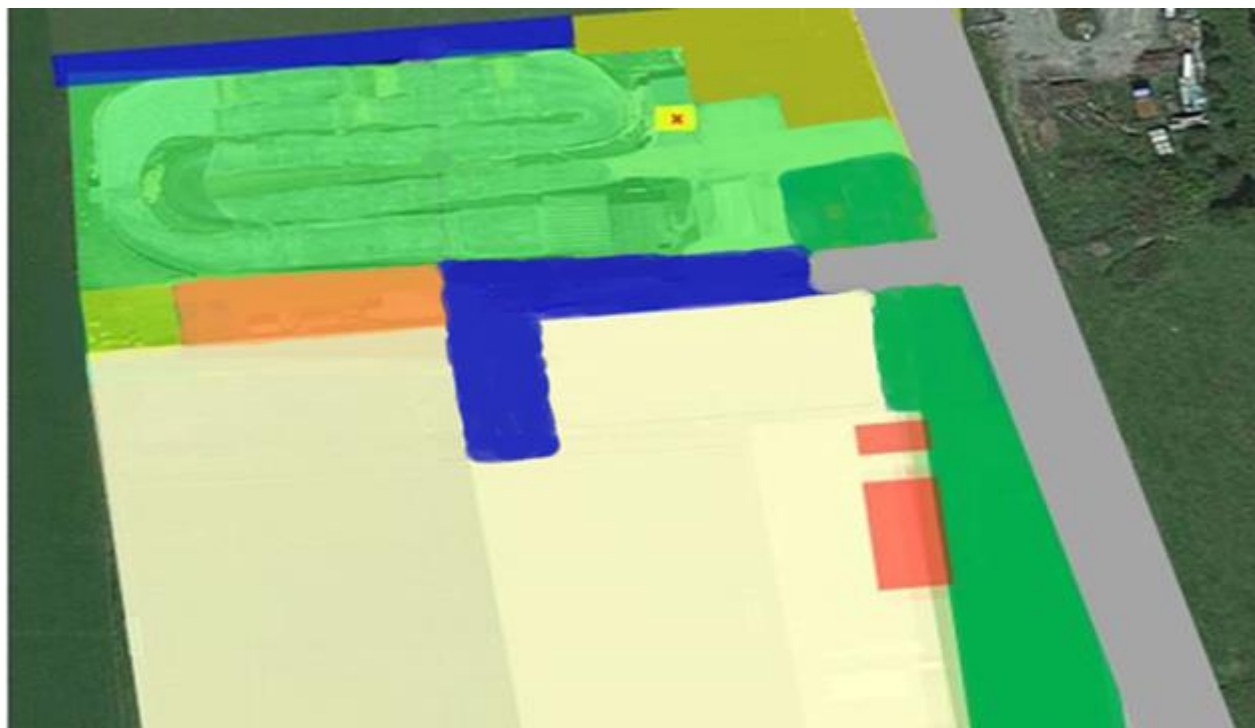
